
# "Youth across the borders"

## The 1st stage of the 2 stage Youth Exchange

Ada | Serbia - September 12-20 2015

#### Summary

The economic "migration" is one of the most actual and unsolved problems in Europe. The countries from where people emigrate loose young, earning-capable, active citizens. The countries where the people emigrate not necesserally get conscious, professional human resource, but many times get social problems.

The youth of the left and the recipient countries meet each other in our programme. Our aim is to make the emigration-planning youth think over the challenges of working abroad. The programme also intends to make them get to know the conditions of those jobs which are legal and valuable for their personal career building. The programme also aims to make the involved ones get to know how to launch an enterprise in the "target countries" of the emigrants. In addition we present them those projects which help the youth how to get a job and build a career in the homeland.

The personal decisions, employment and enterprising successes have effects on the economy as well as the social processes of the countries and Europe. During our project we analyse the european economic mobility. Our aims are to discover the causes of the problems, to put forward various suggestions for solving these problems, to present good practices, examples, innovative projects, and to form a ready to enterprise motivation for the extant will of getting a job abroad.

The project seeks the solution to reduce unemployment of the youth as well as tries to roll back the negative cultural prejudice against them.

Besides the rationalization of employment mobility we would like to strenghten the cultural inclusion and acceptance in both sides. Our aim is to reduce the negative stereotypes, prejudice against the citizens of the "migrant counries", especially those ones which affects youth.

During the project we apply non-formal pedagogic methods.

The outcomes of the programme will be summarized and multiplicated on the internet (web-sites and social pages) and in a publication.

The programme will be implemented in two locations: in Ada, Serbia between 12-20 September 2015 and in Nyíregyháza, Hungary between 9-17 April 2016.

#### Objectives of the second exchange in Serbia (12-20 September 2015 ):

- Search and analyze the reasons uf Youth Unemployment a achieve a common idea of employability.
- To analyze the reasons of the migration of Unemployed youth people
- To explore the barriers of Youth employability and find a possible solutions to cross these barriers.
- To find and realize good practice, new methods, which we can use in everyday life.
- Made a good team from the participants to after their return made some researches in their communities.
- To know new cultures and learn how to implement in new cultural environment.

Youth Exchange activities will use non formal education methodologies and will be centered on participants' input and experience as the main source of mutual learning.

#### Application

Every partner organization will do the application procedure by themselves. We are give you the possibility to find the best participants for this exchange.

#### Participants profiles:

- Unemployed Young people between the age of 18 and 25
- Excellent English language skills.
- Interest and commitment to attend the full duration of the exchange
- Partticipants from: **Spain, Italy, Serbia and Hungary**

#### Financial Condition/ Travel Cost:

The Youth Exchange will be implemented in the frame of the Erasmus + Programme:

- Accommodation and food will be covered fully by the organizer.
- Health insurance is obligatory and should be arranged and covered by each participant.
- Travel expenses will be reimbursed according to Erasmus + rules as follow:

#### To the 1<sup>st</sup> part in Serbia:

-Participants from Italy (Torino): <u>140 Euro</u> Maximum reimbursements for the travel costs from Torino to Ada and back+ the organizers will provide a free transfer for the participants from Belgrade/Budapest to Ada and Back.

-Participants from Spain (Pontevedra) <u>240 Euro</u> Maximum reimbursements for the travel costs from Pontevedra to Ada and back+ the organizers will provide a free transfer for the participants from Belgrade/Budapest to Ada and Back.

For the Airports, you can use the Belgrad airport in Serbia or the Budapest airport in Hungary.

#### IMPORTANT!!!:

After buying travel ticket please ask for invoices in a name and other dates for the coordinating organization. Its important because the project is funded by the Hungarian NA and at the end of the project we need to prove our expenses respecting the Hungarian Tax Law, which is asking as for original invoices in a neme of the organization who receive the money from the Hungarian NA.

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#### Notes:

- Early arrivals or late departure will be the own responsibility of the participants. Please bear in mind that according to the guidelines of Erasmus+ program the travel back must be realized by participants on direct way within maximum of 2 days. In case of longer stays or indirect travel (holiday travel, etc) there is no chance of reimbursement.
- Registration is final upon arrangement of the travel: Once selected to participate, you need to arrange your travel ASAP to reserve your seat in the Exchange
- Do not purchase any tickets without consulting with us

#### Venue: Accomodation and Food in Ada Serbia

The Youth Exchange will be hosted in the Hunting house 30 minutes from the center of the city in the quiet place where we organized already 4 international programs with great success.

Organizers will provide participants with accommodation (participants will share rooms- From 2 to 4 participants in 1 Room) three meals per day & 2 coffee breaks. Please, keep in mind, that the provided food may differ from the food you are used to have in your country, and, even in case of providing food for special groups, e.g. vegetarians, it may not fully meet your expectations. We strongly recommend participants to inform the organizers IN ADVANCE about any special needs.



Checklist – what you need to bring with you:

 Proof of all the travel expenses you wish to reclaim: No payment will be made without a proof of your expenses! If you come by plane, please be sure to bring evidence of the sum actually paid (invoice in a name of the coordinating organisation, copy of credit card slip), a copy of the ticket and your boarding passes, or in the case of an email booking, a print out of the reservation confirmation and financial transaction. DO KEEP ALL FLIGHT/TRAIN/BUS TICKETS, BOARDING CARDS, INVOICES ETC WITH YOU AND DO NOT THROW THEM AWAY!!!

 $\circ~$  Other Expenses: All other expenses during the activity, such as board, lodging and transportation, will be borne by the organizers. However, all participants' personal costs (like telephone calls, gifts and souvenirs, etc.) and/or any other cost not linked to programe's events have to be covered by the participants and will be settled directly by them.

 $\circ$  "Standard seminar equipment": An alarm clock, any dictionaries you might require, music CDs and tapes, instruments that you may need, comfortable clothes, warm clothes to be worn both inside and outside, etc

 $\circ~$  Please bring all necessary identity documents (social and medical insurance, I.D. etc.) in the case of need.

• Any materials you need to present you country (food, drinks, music, post cards) during the intercultural evening, specific working methods or tools)

• Personal hygiene equipments (Tooth paste, shower gel, etc.)

#### Local Money:

The Serbian Currency is called SERBIAN Dinar. In the shops US dollars and Euros are not taken. There are many places in Ada where you may exchange money (from Euros and US dollars). We recommend using cash instead of credit or debit cards as fees usually have to be paid when withdrawing money in Serbia. We recommend you to not change your money at the Airpot. 1 Euro is around 120 Serbian Dinar in the most of the exchange offices.

#### Things to prepeare:

- A short presentation about your country for cultural night (Please be creative and avoid Youtube videos if its possible.
- Short presentation about your organizations.
- Collect and make a presentation about good practice and successful Examples of Self employment, entrepreneurship and successful business ideas in Your region, local communities or neiborhood.

#### Organizers:

The exchange in Serbia will be implemented by "Youth Organisation IFIX" in cooperation with its partners and is responsible for organization, administration and logistics of the exchange in Serbia.
