About the Project

The international training course "Enter Our Ship: The Entrepreneurship!" is seeking to train and equip youth workers and leaders who work directly with young, unemployed people (especially in deprived, rural and urban areas) with essential business and entrepreneurial knowledge and skills, in order to make them able to contribute to the limitation of unemployability among youth, mainly through promoting self-employment and entrepreneurial culture.

Entrepreneurial experiences – such as making mistakes, trying a concept, developing ideas, actually building, managing, and growing organizations, raising real funds, failing, trying again, building intellectual capital and managing it, and translating intellectual value into economic and social value – should be the acid test in being able to develop an educated opinion about entrepreneurship. Therefore, by converting all these real examples into practical activities, the trainers and the experts on entrepreneurial fields will be able to attract the attention and the imagination of young people and provide them with all the essential tools for taking conscious decisions based on realistic economic and social conditions.

Young leaders from our organizations recognized the need of practical education on entrepreneurship and prepared project called "Enter Our Ship: The Entrepreneurship!" that will be hosted in Roubaix by Organisation Française de la Coopération Internationale from 7/08/2016 until 13/08/2016 in cooperation with partner organizations from Spain, Poland, Italy, Romania, Turkey, Slovakia, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Lithuania, Greece, Portugal that will be represented by 2 participants each.

The paramount aim of this projects is to apply entrepreneurship activities by using non-formal methods to practice entrepreneurship in such a way that youth workers could provide young people with a range of potentials on entrepreneurship!

The Objectives

- -To promote practical methods in approaching entrepreneurship education.
- Practice to practice entrepreneurship through workshops and practical exercises
- To understand changing and dynamic nature of entrepreneurship.
- To empower job seekers to become self-employed.
- -To develop creative and entrepreneurial spirit of young people.
- To acquire skills and specific knowledge using non-formal education by developing of human personality and developing set of skills necessary for entrepreneurs.
- To develop new contacts with organizations from EU to create stronger partnerships for future projects in the European context.
- -To promote and develop innovative ideas and share good practices.






ROUBAIX

Roubaix is a 94'000 inhabitants city situated 230 km in the north of Paris and 100 km in the west of Brussels. Roubaix used to the be the world capital of textile before China took the leadership, it was especially famous for wool crafting. Since then, unemployement is raging and factories have



been turned into giant cloth shopping centers, museums, accomodations and offices.

- "Dofus" which is the second most played online video game has been developed in Roubaix.
- "OVH", which is famous to be amongst the biggest web site hosting service companies in the world and for having hosted Wikileaks website, has its headquarters in Roubaix.





FOOD&LODGING

You will stay in the city center in a Ibis Hotel.

Accommodations will be in twin bedrooms, so participants will share rooms. Every room has its own bathroom. There will be towels, some hygiene products.

Breakfasts, Lunches and Dinners will take place at the hotel and the activities will be in a Youth Center or in OFCI headquarters nearby



WFATHER

Usually, the temperature can go from 18 to 32 degrees celcius during Summer in Roubaix. During the night it can be quite cold and windy, during the day it might be sunny and sometimes rainy. Obviously the weather is very random and we would advise you to summer cloth and also sweaters just in case the weather turns wrong.

PRACTICAL DETAILS FOR TRANSPORT

TRANSPORT: Please, inform us as soon as possible when and how you will come. Book tickets after confirming with us, as soon as possible and send us your reservations please. There are quite a lot of airports nearby. We advise you to come through the Bruxelles Charleroi Airport or Paris Charles de Gaulle (Roissy Airport).

There are two airports in Belgium which are close to the project location and which propose cheap flights:

- -Bruxelles Charleroi served with almost all low cost airlines (RyanAir, WizzAir, Jetairfly, Easy Jet, Pegasus Airlines, etc...), There are shuttles every hour under the FLIBCO company which goes to Lille Center (duration: 1 hour and 30 minutes) where we will pick you up to the project location which is situated 20 minutes by metro from it.
- -Bruxelles Zaventhem with International normal cost flights coming from almost everywhere in the world. A train station is situated inside the airport with trains to Lille Center (duration : 1 hour and 30 minutes) where we will pick you up to the project location which is situated 20 minutes by metro from it.

There is one airport in Lille-Lesquin, but only a few flight lines go through it, there are shuttles going from it to Lille Center where we will pick you up to the project location which is situated 20 minutes by metro from it.

There are three airports in Paris which are close to the project location and which propose flights from Europe and the rest of the World but we don't really recommend them because the flights are expansive or it's complicated to go from there to Lille:

- -Charles de Gaulle (Roissy) it has a train station with a train going directly to Lille (50 minutes but a bit expansive)
- -Orly
- -Beauvais (RyanAir/WizzAir Airport)

It is very important that you keep all the bills, tickets and boarding passes from your travel, so that we will be able to reimburse you the costs of your transport. Original tickets and the boarding passes from the whole group must be collected at your return home, and send back to local partner. If you forget, we will be not able to reimburse you!


