ABOUT InterACTive COLORS

InterACTive Colors Project is the 3rd part of a series of projects working with the LGBTQIA+ context and social inclusion.

Through this project and its Exchange activity, our intention is to provide to all people involved, including you, a safe space and opportunity for learning, growing and acting.

Mission:

Our aim is to promote social inclusion and active citizenship of young LGBTQIA+ people in society, while enhancing cooperation between its partners in the youth field of LGBTQIA+.

- To **produce** 10 informal educational videos with LGBTQIA+ content & dissemination of them in an online platform/blog/webpage

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING: #LEARNGROWACT

LEARNING TO GROW, GROWING TO ACT.

We as organizers, create a playing field for all people involved, in which we can play to learn and learn to play.

Within the given group, you take part in the Exhange for yourself and with yourself as an individual. You are the actor of your own learning and creator of your own experience. By choosing your own involvement in the exchange, you lighten up the path to your own learning and desired outcomes.

The diverse activities are created in a way to encourage your self-awareness, InterACTive participation and to support you in discovering your personal style and connection to self-empowerment. There are indoor and outdoor activities, processes and exercises. Some of the activities are accompanied by music, game and play.

The activities are there to challenge your own ability in creating desired results and to give freedom to your creativity and greatness. The activities will be done either individually, in pairs, in small groups or in the big group. By working in an intercultural context together with the rest of the actors, you have the chance to create togetherness and support each other throughout the whole duration of the project, while enjoying.

The Exchange is all about learning by experiencing, i.e. learning by doing and learning by involvement.

The focus is set on participants, you as active learner who are at all times accountable for your own learning.

WHAT YOU CAN WORK ON AND EXPLORE DURING THE EXCHANGE:

Learn, experience and reflect about yourself:

How you are, feel, learn, cooperate, communicate, plan, organize, lead or follow, manage your timing, play, ,when working as an individual, in pairs, smaller teams or in a big group

How you are and work in an intercultural context, how you respond to challenges, how you give and receive support, how you make connections with other people

Learn, acquire and practice your digital skills by using diverse digital tools, such as photography, video, social media, webpage (online platform)

Practice, learn and get better on giving and receiving constructive feedback and support other people in their development as well your own

WORKING METHODS & APPROACH

- **Personal Development tools**, processes and exercises, for working on your personal growth and self-awareness
- **Reflection groups** in order to reflect on your own learning process and goals in a daily basis.
- **Inter-cultural learning** through at all times in diverse groups from different cultures and nationalities
- **Outdoor part activities** in which you get to meet and interact with the Dutch local community of Ommen and other areas
- Body-movement, theater activities, art and games, in order for body / self-awareness and self-expression
- Activities using digital tools, such as social media, multimedia (video & photography), online platform(webpage, blog etc)

During the 10 working days of the Exchange, you will have the chance to work on your personal growth, Raise Your Digital Muscles and achieve the below:

- 1. Creation of an online platform
- 2. Production of 10 informal Educational Videos connected to LGBTQIA+ context, which will be uploaded in the platform 3. Creation of a short booklet/toolkit on
- education, inclusion and LGBTQIA+ context

INTERACTIVE CRITERIA:

The playground will be owned by a total of 45 people, 5 per country (including group leaders), who are resident in one of the partner countries represented by the 9 organizations involved in this project.

YOU CAN APPLY FOR THE PROJECT IF YOU ARE:

- Between the age of 18-30 years old (only for group leaders there is no age limit)
- Coming from the LGBTQIA+ or heterosexual community and you are eager to explore your own identity and self-expression, while exchanging new ways and actions of promoting the LGBTQIA+ rights and inclusion in your country
- Willing to work on your personal development and self-awareness, increase your personal competences, self-empowerment and enhance intercultural awareness

- Involved in LGBTQIA+ organizations or you are an activist in the field or you are familiar with the topic
- enjoy using digital tools (video, social media, photography, webpages etc) and you are interested to expand your learning, skills and practices
- Able to work in simple English
- Highly motivated and willing to actively participate during the whole duration of the project and the exchange itself

A commitment to the program and an active contribution for creating your own experience and involvement, while simultaneously respecting the view of others.

PLAYING CONTRIBUTION:

There is a participation fee of 50 €.

It is the part, when after the Exchange you will have personal evaluation of your learning and experience together with your group leader and partner organization. You will also be supported by your sending organization in implementing your follow-up planning, continue carrying out the online platform, promoting the project and results you will have created. Additionally, receive support in organizing any additional activities (workshops, seminars etc), raising awareness actions (free hugs, flashmobs, interviewing local etc) or other events in your local community, writing articles, testimonials or creating newprojects implementing media.

YOUTHPASS

LOCATION:

The project will take place in and around the group accommodation buildings of the Olde Vechte Foundation. Hosting and catering will be provided by the foundation.
