ABOUT THE PROJECT

In the present period of severe economic crisis and economic recession, social entrepreneurship is one of the main issues at European and national public policy level. The European Commission stresses that there are cultural, educational and economic factors which discourage too many people from starting a business and therefore there is a need to develop a more entrepreneurial culture, among EU citizens in general. The lack of knowledge and resources to kick-start these ambitions do not allow them to progress. For this reason, developing a social entrepreneurship education with a European scope would address this issue in a transnational way, thus increasing the potential participation and activation of youth and adults in EU.

The development of new small businesses does not only empower the economic situation through the creation of new jobs, but it also provides solutions to change society for the better.

we aim to familiarize youth workers with the new trend called 'social entrepreneurship', in order to be capable to assimilate the appropriate skills and tools which could potentially lead to the concrete education of the young people, on the fields associated with a construction of sustainable social enterprise.

THE OBJECTIVES

- To acquaint with the principles of 'social entrepreneurship'.
- To share practical non-formal educational methods that motivate, and therefore engage young people with activities related to social entrepreneurship.
- To acquire the appropriate skills which would enable the youth workers in order to support young people to build social enterprises that address the challenges of our time.
- To share national resources and inform about European ones (entrepreneurship education and learning, access to different types of funding, partnerships, networks etc.) useful for social enterprise creation and sustainability;
- To create strong partnerships, capable to develop future projects concerning social entrepreneurship.

ACTIVITIES...

The activities will be co-ordinated through non formal education methods (as group work and activities, presentations, workshops, study visit and personal assignments, meetings with trainers, experts etc). During some activities participants will explore the specific issues, reflecting methods and its impacts and simulation exercises for skills development.



The programme will include international nights for which we ask you to bring your local food, beverages, traditional games and music, traditional dress and anything you think that might represent your culture/country. You will also be able to screen videos about your country and organise a quiz or anything to entertain and introduce your culture to the other participants.

Some activities will require from you to have a laptop, so please bring one if you have, but be careful to protect it well



THE VENUE

The venue of the project is a village near Toulouse.

Toulouse is the capital city of the southwestern French department of Haute-Garonne, as well as of the Occitanie region. The Toulouse Metro area is, with 1 312 304 inhabitants as of 2014, France's 4th metropolitan area after Paris, Lyon and Marseille and ahead of Lille and Bordeaux.

Toulouse is the centre of the European aerospace industry and the city also hosts the European headquarters of Intel and CNES's Toulouse Space Centre (CST), the largest space centre in Europe. Its world-renowned university is one of the oldest in Europe (founded in 1229).

WEATHER



Toulouse has a humid subtropical climate which can be qualified as “submediterranean” due to its proximity to the Mediterranean climate zone. Usually the temperature can go from 7 to 18 degrees celsius during April in Toulouse. During the night it can be quite cold and windy, during the day it might be sunny with clouds and sometimes rainy. Obviously the weather is very random and we would advise you to take rain-coats and sweaters just in case the weather turns really wrong.
