

BYM Building resilient YOU(TH) through media literacy









"Building resilient YOU(TH) through media literacy" is an international youth exchange that will take place in Sardinia (near Cagliari) from 12 to 19 June 2022 and will be carried out within the Erasmus + program. The project will involve 35 young people from Italy, Spain, Poland, Netherlands and Cyprus.

The activity aims to equip 35 young people with competencies and practical guidelines in Media and Information Literacy fostering their personal and social development

OBJECTIVES

1) to foster media and information literacy for critical civic empowerment and engagement of young citizens,

2) to raise awareness, stimulate understanding and critical thinking of youngsters while interacting in online space,

3) to build capacities of young people to integrate elements of MIL in practical activities in the youth work (peer education, news reporting, podcasting, blogs, videos).







- Ice breaking activities;
- Simulation activities, brainstorming and role plays;
- Discussions;
- Presentation supported by videos, flipcharts, power point; photos etc.;
- Creative methods of storytelling;
- Workshops with experts, outdoor activities and photo shooting;
- Group activities (working in small and medium groups).

Theoretical approach (especially modules connected with basic skills) will be provided by the facilitators through Power Point presentations, video and some theories and materials for the participants.

Each delegation will consist of 6 young people aged between 18 and 25 plus 1 team leader. Priority will be given to the participation of young NEETs or those from social distress groups.

- Be aware of the importance of mutual understanding between peoples;
- Be aware of the importance of associations, especially youth associations;
- Have the will to make available to their peers the skills acquired during the exchange;
- Promote knowledge of your local community through online dissemination activities;









The selection of participants will be done through cooperation of the hosting and sending organizations according to the participant profiles in the application form. The selection will be finalized by the end of 20th of May, 2022. The selected participant BEFORE buying the tickets will fill an application form.



Do not buy any ticket without our confirmation. Before buying the tickets, you should always send the travel plan of the participant for our authorization so you may proceed. Tickets should be bought with insurance for cancelation to prevent any inconvenience concerning COVID-19.



COVID-19 MEASURES IN ITALY

In Italy all the people who completed vaccination process are allowed to enter. They only request Green Pass or Vaccination doc witnessing it & to fill passenger locator form in advance. From the first of May should be not be compulsory anymore to have a green certificate to enter in restourant and hotels, but we will keep you posted on that. Financial procedure for travel reimbursement



SPAIN - 7 pax - 360€ per person CYPRUS - 7 pax - 360€ per person NETHERLANDS - 7 pax - 275€ per person POLAND - 7 pax - 275€ per person ITALY - 7 pax - 0€ per person

NOTICE

The travel reimbursement will be done by bank transfer only to the partner organization accounts for their group of participants or to one of the participants involve who will take responsibility, according to the rules by the National Agency.

The reimbursement will be done ONLY when the following steps are done:

• Collect and provide the invoices; tickets (there must be a price, name of the person and mean of payment stated on it);

• All boarding passes;

• Mobility report filled by the participant.



TICKETS will be reimbursed considering only the official address of the sending organisation.

For ex:

If the city of official address of the sending organisation is Braga.

BRAGA-CAGLIARI= It will be reimbursed

OPORTO-BRAGA= it won't be reimbursed, since just the travel from Braga con be reimbursed and NOT how to reach Braga airport.
