project methods.

1. SYSTEMIC APPROACH

- UNDERSTANDING THAT INDIVIDUALS ARE EMBEDDED IN A SOCIAL CONTEXT TINGED BY POWER STRUCTURES
- FOCUSING ON RELATIONSHIPS, FOR EXAMPLE BETWEEN "YOUTH WORKER" AND "TARGET GROUP"
- INCLUDING REFLEXIVITY OVER ONE'S RELATION TO THE TARGET GROUP

2. INFORMAL I FARNING

- LEARNING FROM EACH OTHERS WORKING EXPERIENCES
- VISUALISING THE ISSUES WHICH ARE HANDLED THROUGH DIFFERENT TOOLS
- COMBINING THEORETICAL LEARNING WITH SYSTEMIC WORK AND THEATRE
- LEARNING THROUGH CREATIVE TOOLS

3. INTERSECTIONAL LEARNING

- UNDERSTANDING THAT POWER STRUCTURES AND OPPRESSION OVERLAP AND COEXIST
- EXPLORING HOW TO APPLY INTERSECTIONAL METHODS INTO SOCIAL JUSTICE WORK AND ANTIRACIST PROJECTS

4. THEATRE OF THE OPPRESSED

- A METHOD DEVELOPED IN THE 1970'S IN BRAZIL
- AIMS TO DECONSTRUCT SYSTEMIC SOCIAL INEQUALITIES BASED ON THE EXPERIENCES AND PERSPECTIVES OF MARGINALISED GROUPS
- INVITES PARTICIPANTS TO PHYSICALLY JOIN THE STAGE, BROADENING THEIR ROLE FROM SPECTATORS TO SPECT-ACTORS.

5. DRIV

- PEACEWORKS' METHOD FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT
- INCLUDES ELEMENTS SUCH AS; NORM CRITICISM AND POWER ANALYSIS; COOPERATION STRATEGIES; VISION AND GOAL FORMULATION; PROJECT PLANNING

 YOU ARE A YOUTH WORKER IF YOU HAVE BEEN WORKING DIRECTLY WITH YOUNG PEOPLE FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS

YOU SHOULD ALSO:

- BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD
- HAVE EXPERIENCE IN WORKING WITH YOUTH FROM DIFFERENT SOCIAL BACKGROUNDS
- BE WILLING TO REFLECT UPON LOCAL AND GLOBAL POWER STRUCTURES, AS WELL AS YOUR ROLE IN REPRODUCING THEM
- BE A RESIDENT IN ONE OF THE COUNTRIES SEEN IN THE TABLE TO THE RIGHT

masculinity.




HÉLÈNE BEAUGEARD
