

- The course venue is located in Österfärnebo, north of Stockholm.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

- You will be reimbursed for your ticket to and from Sweden up to the limits which are seen in the table to the right.
- We will arrange joint transportation to and from the venue: departure from Stockholm Central Station on the 6th.

PRACTICALS

- You will be staying at Färnebo Folkhögskola in two different houses where you will be divided into shared rooms in groups of 2 or 3.
- In the houses there are shared bathroom and shower facilities.
- Meals will be provided 3 times per day in addition to some light refreshments in between sessions.
