Environment and climate action are key priorities for the EU now and in the future. The European Green Deal is the European new growth strategy and recognizes the key role of schools, and training institutions to engage with youth on the changes needed for a successful transition to becoming climate neutral by 2050.

This project is a key instrument for building knowledge, skills, and attitudes on supporting sustainable development in Europe. The project will be an opportunity for young people to connect with nature. And what's better than implementing this project on a farm in rural Italy, surrounded by orange trees, learning how to cultivate them, take care of them, collect the fruits and learn about all the health benefits of this wonderful and highly nutritious citrus fruit? Of course, a youth exchange in nature, surrounded by fruitful trees and living a week as a local.

Our project will educate young people and promote the culture of sustainable development goals, developing green sectoral skills strategies and methodologies.

Coming from cities that boast a long tradition of oranges production, we believe we have a lot to share and receive from our partners. This project will guide the participants to rediscover the health benefits and nutrition facts of the oranges, to learn how important our well-being is in order to achieve our goals, and also to learn professions related to the orange tree, providing them with stimulating ideas on innovation and entrepreneurship, giving them skills to care and take all the advantages from nature, in order to learn that everything comes from the nature and that we must take care of. Thanks to the practical structure of the workshops and the close relationship with agriculture and wellbeing, this project has made it easier to involve people with fewer opportunities and difficulties learning.

European rural areas provide us with our food, homes, jobs, and essential ecosystem services. We believe that is very important to ensure that rural areas can continue to play these essential roles. That's why European Commission communication has set out a long-term vision for the EU's rural areas up to 2040. It identifies areas of action toward stronger, connected, resilient and prosperous rural areas and communities. We as stakeholders of this European challenge want to be involved in building an impact through our project.

- - Promote social inclusion, involving young people with fewer opportunities in our group
- - Promote well-being by promoting the advantages of living in rural areas and the health benefits of it
- - Establish lifelong connections between participants and create partnerships with respect to environmental and sustainable

- - Increase understanding and intercultural communication among EU citizens.

PARTNERS, PARTICIPANTS AND TRAVEL COSTS REIMBURSEMENT

The APV will host 2 leaders. The Youth Exchange will host 36 young people aged 18 - 25 (5 + 1 group leaders with no age limits), coming from 6 European and Non-European countries.

It is possible to come to <u>Italy max. 1</u> day before the official arrival day OR leave max.1 day after the official departure day.

If you can prove there is a better/cheaper travel connection. Please be aware that we are not able to refund any costs for your accommodation, food etc. during these extra days.

We will refund only travel tickets that we approved prior purchase!

We kindly ask you to choose the most economical and eco-friendly way of transport (e.g. student fares, low cost airlines, 2nd class trains, etc.). Also, be aware of your travel cost limitation. We reimburse the travel cost ONLY up to the limit designed for your country. We will also reimburse only those tickets that will show the currency, dates of your travel, places you are traveling from/to and your name (or number of passengers). It is important to keep all your tickets (also from your local buses and trains). It is NOT possible to travel by car or taxi!

The travel costs within the budget limit of your country (please see above) will be reimbursed after the training course to the bank account of your sending organization and only if these 3 conditions are fulfilled:

- 1) You gave all the ORIGINAL tickets to our organization. It's fundamental to bring the invoices or the travel confirmations where is clearly shown the price;
- 2) You attended the full duration of the youth exchange;
- 3) You submitted all reports that our organization or EU requested.

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

You will be accommodated in B&B Blued and Masseria Usamborgia (in rooms for 3-4 persons.

There are bed sheets, towels, TV and bathroom in each room. The pension also offers free Wi-Fi, swimming pool and a terrace.

The venue is situated in Avola, no transportation needed to go to the city center, it is situated in a peaceful surrounding.

Noto or Avola are beautiful, unique and safe touristic cities, most of its historical monuments are part of the UNESCO heritage.

INTERCULTURAL EVENING

During the project, we plan to arrange an Intercultural evening. You will present your own cultures — national, regional, personal or any kind of culture you feel you belong to. A culture may be presented by a song, a story, a poem, a dance, some drink or food, etc. You may bring pictures, music or anything which you consider to be most appropriate to present your culture.

We appreciate it if you find some creative way to present your culture. We will not have a kitchen to prepare the meals for the intercultural evening, so we suggest that you adapt your food and drinks to that reality.

So, in short it should not be a presentation, it should be an activity or something and it is up to you to replace the word something.



December is usually cold, with temperatures about 20 to 29 °C. It might be Warm in the morning, sunny, during the day and cold at night. The weather can vary, so please do check the weather forecast for Avola before you pack your suitcase.

Most of the course will be held indoors. Take your medication – it is good to take pills from your country (you know yourself the best so take painkillers, antipyretic, something against cold that works for you.

<u>In case you need visa</u>, please apply for them immediately as we confirm your participation because it may take a long time. If you need an invitation letter from us, please let us know. There is a budget of **80 Euro** per person for participants who are applying for the visa to enter Italy.

INSURANCE, MEDICAL AND SAFETY ADVICES

Please, be aware that it is compulsory for all participants to have **travel insurance** covering the whole duration of your stay in Italy, including the days of your arrival and departure. Travel insurance cannot be covered by us, but you are obliged to arrange it, please make sure to be vaccinated against COVID before you come to the project, it's mandatory to have your COVID pass with you when you enter Italy.

Please bring your European Health Insurance Card (the blue one) in case of some emergency.

PCR TEST COVERED: in case you need a PCR test to enter Italy, we have a budget of 100 Euros per person to cover the mentioned cost.
