It supports you to actively contribute, create balance and motivate growth in the groups you are part of! It is also a superpower that allows you to welcome different people, teams, and experiences in your life!

We are committed to creating a meaningful and inclusive learning experience for young people, an experience that fosters cooperation, an experience that values co-creation. Through a unique and informal learning environment, we aim to strengthen your teamwork skills.

Together, we will plant seeds that can blossom later on and deeply influence your life back home. You may change your perspective and learn to reframe the contexts you create around you!

Team Up is all about learning by doing, together with others, caring for a shared space, and exploring your role in the groups while solving the arising challenges on your journey!



About the project

Being part of Team Up you will have the chance to discover:

- how you can include yourself in a group;
- what your unique strengths are and how you can use them;
- how you can explore and share your values and your vision;
- how you can learn through informal settings;
- how you can guide your own learning process;
- how you can connect with others while overcoming communication barriers;
- how you can share your experience and knowledge with others;
- how to do all this in a sustainable community created by you and all the others;
- how you can be resilient and use cooperation to achieve your goals.

You have an active role in the concept of this project! You should count on experimenting the unexpected and co-creating from scratch, thus absorbing all the magic that such a learning frame can hold!





How do we do it?

In the **Team Up** playground, we invite you to experience pure and hard cooperation, from simple games to most challenging tasks. We encourage you to reflect on your attitudes as part of a team while appreciating the beauty of peer-to-peer education.

Despite all the games and activities, we encourage you as a team to brainstorm, create, shape, experiment, and take the experience into your own hands, in other words, to create activities and learning opportunities for your selves!



Our core beliefs are:

- 01. Learning is deeper and more lasting when it is based on **learning by doing.** Through this experience, you can all feel responsible for your learning process while developing your skills and testing your own ideas you should be prepared to take action and create!
- 02. Everyone has something unique and valuable to offer. The context of **peer-to-peer** learning will allow you to share your full potential. You will return home inspired by other people that share this experience with you!
- 03. Our method relies on **outdoor** and **nature-based education** as an empowering tool when it comes to leadership, teamwork, and resilience skills you can expect from radical outdoor activities to reflection sessions in a natural environment!

How do we do it?

When people have fun they are better, enjoy life more and are more tolerant. **Team Up** is a summer opportunity for you to play and have fun while moving, growing and changing perspectives!

Your active participation as part of the group will:

- support *self-development* communication, conflict resolution, and active listening;
- build cooperation abilities you will have opportunities to take on leadership roles, delegate tasks, and motivate your team members;
- foster cross-cultural understanding by working together with various countries and cultural backgrounds on shared objectives;
- develop problem-solving skills while looking for solutions, analyzing challenges, and adapting to changing circumstances;
- expand creativity and resilience you will find your role in a team and co-create experiences together, your imagination will run wild.



You will:

- play and learn outside in different settings;
- create a common living space with the rest of the group;
- discover practical ways how to include yourself and others;
- create and organize games/activities for each other;
- go on a hiking/biking/rafting adventure in the Netherlands;
- share your learnings within an intercultural group;
- have an unforgettable summer experience.

During this project...

You will create, play and experiment within an intercultural group of 42 people from 7 different countries.

During the **online preparation meeting**, one participant together with the group leader will have the opportunity to get to know us while working on the program design of the youth exchange. This is how we prepare the ground for learning and we focus on creating a tailor-made educational experience.

During the **exchange**, you will learn and exchange work forms around the topic of self-development — focused on teamwork and peer-to-peer learning — a combination of tools, processes, and theories. We plan to offer and engage the group to create the ultimate mixture of active-like and zen-like activities.

You can expect 10 packed and dynamic days through which you will have the chance to design your own learning process. This experience also includes outdoor challenges — a chance to put into practice all your learnings while testing your cooperation skills.



In your national group you will create local activities. Moreover, you will create media content to share on public platforms – visual media (pictures, videos) from the project and paragraphs about your experience in the exchange (and in the whole project).

After returning home, you will create a storytelling video to share the many benefits of informal and intercultural learning focused on peer-to-peer education and cooperation.

Travel reimbursement

For the YE, you can either use the green travel option or the non-green option. Regardless, you will get the full travel reimbursement amount at the end of the event, according to the country you are coming from.

Participation fee:

In case you choose the non-green travel option, there is a 75 euro participation fee for the exchange. It will be deducted from the travel reimbursement that you will receive after the exchange. This way, you will not be asked to pay the fee in cash. For example – if your travel cost up to 234 euro, that's what you receive as a reimbursement (309 euro reimbursement minus 75 euro fee).
